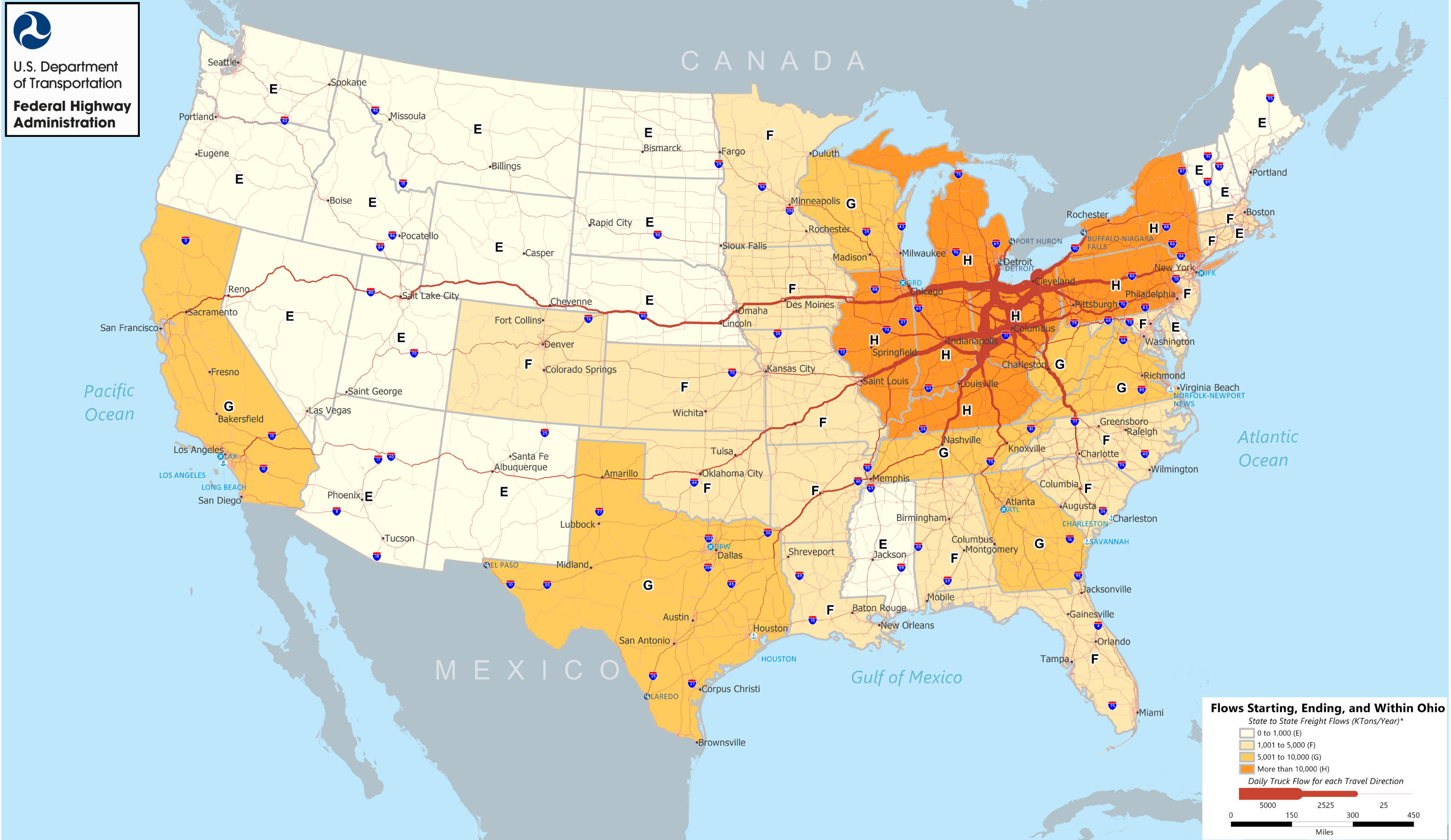


Estimated FAF Flow for Trucks Going To, From, and Within Ohio on National Highway System 2017
